**Re: Road Traffic Accident, Bingham, July 19<sup>th</sup> 20**

We have been instructed by Mrs D. Betts in connection with a road traffic accident in Main Street, Bingham on July 19<sup>th</sup> 20\_\_, near the junction with Oscrey Terrace.

Our client informs us that she was driving in a westerly direction towards Blakeforth in her Volvo estate, registration number LR36 666TMY, when she was struck by a car, registration number F 638 ENT, driven by you, travelling in the opposite direction. Our client alleges that the accident was caused by your negligence in that your vehicle crossed the central line marking while overtaking a bus.

As a result of the impact Mrs Betts' car collided with a lamp post and she suffered personal injury and damage to the vehicle. Our client suffered cuts, bruises, abrasions and a whiplash injury, and was treated in Accident and Emergency Department at Loamshire General Hospital on the 19th July under hospital reference number ..... Our client is employed as a receptionist, earning £29,000 per annum, and is expected to remain off work until at least the end of September. She is continuing treatment as an outpatient.

We are obtaining a police report of the accident and will be pleased to provide a copy on receipt of your undertaking to pay half of the fee for same.

Please find enclosed a copy of a standard disclosure list, on which we have marked those documents that we anticipate will be relevant in this action.

We have sent a copy of this letter to Beeswax Insurance Company, quoting the details you provided to our Client at the scene of the accident. We would be grateful for confirmation from your Insurers that liability is not in dispute within the next twenty-one (21) days.
