Legislative Waiver/	The legislature has dictated, through a statute, that certain youths
Statutory Exclusion	must be tried in the adult court—the juvenile court is excluded from
	hearing the case.
Once/Always	Once a youth has been adjudicated in adult court, the youth is
	permanently under the adult court's jurisdiction.
Reverse Waiver	Criminal courts can return certain cases to the juvenile court.
